## **1. COMPANY BACKGROUND**

HUDUMA HARDWARE (DHH) has a long history in Tanzania and came into operations in the name of KUKAYA HARDWARE (KH) in Shinyanga. KH had been involved in the service provision of various hand pumps since 1997.

KH as a service provider in the water sector has been doing research in solar pumps, and its innovations are now widely being used in the field by various stake holders.

Working closely with the Dutch funded program (DWSP) in Shinyanga and the Community Based Resource Centre (CBRC) also initiated by the Dutch project played a very big role in the region by providing quality assurance and installation of different hand pumps, forming and Training of Water user groups and stockiest for hand pump spare parts for sustainability.

KH has been working in the quality assurance of the pumps being supplied to Shinyanga through him as the Tanira Ltd pump agent and supplied more than 1200 hand pumps for Shinyanga Region.

The Proprietor of KH Mr. Riaz Sachedina proudly served as honorary member and a vice Chairman of CBRC for 3 years.

## **2. OUR PROJECTS**

### **HAND PUMPS**

DHH has an experience of importing hand pumps from an ISO, UNICEF & SKAT-HTN recognized company. DHH has imported and supplied to various NGO's, RWSSP programs, Religious organizations and many other similar organizations by building a solid reputation and name for itself.

Being quality conscious, convenience and service oriented, it has provided competitive and good quality products that are durable and could withstand the local environmental situations existing in Tanzania with an assurance of the availability of spares and after sales service.

DHH tapping all the experience of KH went full fledge into under taking different water projects in the country and also ventured for alternate lighting energy and solar water pump business in the early part of 2004 by first introducing affordable solar lanterns for the rural people of Tanzania.

After successfully launching the lanterns it started supplying solar home lighting systems and pioneered in the introduction of SOLAR FORCE LIFT PUMP (SFLP), a system harnessing the sun energy and provides water for various usages like hospitals, schools, irrigation schemes etc.

The efficacious of these pumps were demonstrated in 2003/2004 at the water week celebrations at Shinyanga and Songea that attracted many water sector investors in Tanzania.

## DRILLING

DHH decided to venture into the drilling business and imported a Drilling Rig With its partners based in Arusha and started a Company AQUAMAN DRILLERS LTD (AMD).

Since the inception of DHH in 2011 the company utilizing its past experience of 15 years has successfully undertaken and completed one of the biggest solar water project of its kind by:-

- a) Supplying, installing and commissioning of 27 village level solar water pumping systems ranging from 600watts – 2400watts system for BP Tanzania in Mtwara region funded by AMREF.
- b) Won a tender in 2012 for installing and supplying 11 solar water pumps to AMREF in Mtwara region.
- c) Supply of 2 diesel engine driven pump coupled with MONO pump for Sustainable environment management Singida (SEMA)
- d) Supply of 4 MONO pumps for MAMADO in Dodoma Region.
